According to Chris *“the broad purpose of the seminars is to provide information on how the canine body works, and what we can do to improve performance and keep our dogs healthy and injury-free... The seminars are highly interactive and provide opportunities for attendees and their dogs to participate in structure and gait analysis, lameness evaluation, to practice conditioning exercises with their dogs and to participate in jump-training and exercises appropriate to targeted performance events.”*

However, the speaker will choose Attendee's dogs to be used for demonstration purposes. There will be opportunities for you to work your own dog, but this is NOT A WORKING SEMINAR.

Topics to be covered include:

The importance of structure to performance, locomotion & lameness, conditioning the performance dog, causes of lameness or reduced performance, jump training, stress & the performance dog, how to pick a performance puppy & keeping old dogs young.

This seminar will be helpful for those participating in any and all dog sports (conformation, obedience, agility, flyball, tracking, herding, field, lure coursing...).

Chris will help us learn how to keep our canine companions healthy and active.

Seminar Fee (both days) : \$120 (pre-registration) or \$150 (day of seminar)

If your dog can't be confined and remain quiet, please don't bring your dog. Any dog that is disruptive or behaves in an aggressive manner as determined by event staff will be requested to leave. Any dog that has "personal space issues" is not allowed in the seminar room.

Remember chairs are right next to each other and people and dogs may be stepping over your dog. It is not a nice experience to be snarled at when dogs/people have to walk "over" your dog.
