This class is unique, as each dog has the chance to set the "Time to Beat" for each jump height division. All levels (Excellent, Open, and Novice run the same course.)

ENTRY INFORMATION

YOU CAN NOW ENTER THE TRIAL VIA AKC'S ONLINE ENTRY SERVICE

Go to the AKC Agility Online Entry Services home page at www.akc.org/AgilityEntry and follow the instructions there to use your 'My AKC' account to enter this event online. . (Please note that AKC charges a small processing fee for each online entry.) During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online or paper will be as follows: 25% online entries (165 runs) and 75% paper entries (495 runs). If either form of entry (paper or online) has not filled at the end of the 48 hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either one accordingly.

Hand deliveries will not be accepted during the first 24 hours after the trial's opening.*

- Limit: 10 entries per envelope. One entry = one dog. Envelopes containing more than 10 entries will be returned. Paper entries received within 24 hours of the opening date and time must: 1) include postage or be metered; 2) be delivered by a multi-state or multi-national postal or carrier service. **Overnight or certified mail must be sent with the "No Signature Required" waiver signed.** If above conditions are not met, the entries are not valid and must be returned to sender.
- Owners are responsible for ensuring that entry forms are completed IN FULL. Entries submitted without ALL information will be returned as invalid.
- All entries must be submitted on official AKC agility entry forms (7/09), one dog per entry form. Photocopies of entry form will be accepted only if legible and official AKC size.
- Entries will not be accepted without signature, fees and reverse side of entry form with agreement signed, nor will credit cards or faxed entries be accepted with paper entries.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry; no refund for duplicate entries. There will be a \$25 service charge for returned checks.
- **YOU DO NOT HAVE TO SEND IN YOUR DOG'S JUMP HEIGHT CARD WITH YOUR ENTRY.**

SIMPLIFIED JUMP HEIGHT CARD PROCESS

NEW ENTRY FORM as of January 2010: The new entry form has a section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or if your dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the *Dogs To Be Measured List*. **It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.**

All agility dogs are required to have an Official Jump Height Card/Valid yellow form and exhibitors must be able to present it at any time during the trial **upon request**. All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. However, if a **Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO)** or an **Agility Field Rep** is present; **ALL** dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form **must** be measured regardless of the jump height entered.. **If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so may result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.**

IMPORTANT PARKING INFORMATION

WATT ARENA NOW CHARGES A \$5.00 PARKING FEE EACH DAY. This is a City of Fort Worth fee, not a club fee. Please do not leave dogs or any valuables in your vehicle at any time. Standard Parking, the parking operator, will have staff at entry points as well as staff walking the facility during normal business hours. DFWMGRC is not responsible for theft or damage.

- Please visit this website - www.culturaldistrictparking.com - for information on parking rates, access points and driving directions. Everyone can purchase parking passes via this website.
- **Two-day or three-day passes at \$5.00 per day may be purchased upon arrival at the parking lot or in advance via www.culturaldistrictparking.com.** You will receive a hang tag with in/out privileges ONLY with a multiple-day pass. Single day passes do not allow for in-and-out privileges. Multi-day passes can be purchased upon arrival, but since this trial is on a very busy weekend with Hunters Extravaganza at the complex, it is recommended that multi-day passes be purchased in advance.
- Attendants will be in place to take money at entry points to the lots. They accept cash or credit card for payment. If you have pre-purchased a multi-day parking pass, just show your receipt to the attendant and you will receive a hang tag to display on your vehicle. During slower business days, payment in the Harley Lot may be self serve with pay & display machines.
- The club is in no way responsible for any parking issues.
- All parking will be on first come, first served basis. Spaces may not be saved.
- The Trial Committee reserves the right to enter or authorize entrance to a vehicle using whatever means necessary to rescue dogs in distress. All persons attending this trial hereby waive any claim for damages against the club for such removal.
- Violators of these parking regulations will be prosecuted and vehicles towed away at the owner's expense without notice.

EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

- Choke collars, pinch collars, prong collars, electric and dummy electric collars are prohibited on trial grounds.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.
- Running order will be determined by computer-generated random draw. Handlers with multiple dogs in one class will have those dogs separated as much as possible.
- All dogs present **must** be on leash or confined in crates when not being judged or at the warm up jump.
- Puppies under six months of age are NOT allowed in the trial site.
- **Watt Arena is now charging \$5.00 per day to park. See additional information elsewhere in this Premium.**
- Exhibitors may wear shirts or insignia of their training group.
- The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all the obstacles safely.
- The Trial Committee reserves the right to enter or authorize entrance to a vehicle using whatever means necessary to rescue dogs in distress. All persons attending this trial hereby waive any claim for damages against the club for such removal.
- The Club and the Trial Secretary have no obligation or responsibility to provide a public address system or stewards to call or locate dogs that are not present at the ring when required. Exhibitors are responsible for being at the gate when it is their turn to run.
- The Club and the Trial Facility will not be responsible for the loss of or damage to any dog exhibited, or for possessions of any exhibitor, whether the result of an accident or any other cause and further assume no responsibility for injury to children. The welfare of an exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this trial is in the care and custody of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is in the trial building or on the grounds at Will Rogers Complex.
- Exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. No refund of entry fees will be made.
- Smoking is not allowed in any building in the Will Rogers Complex.
- Dogs **may not** be left overnight at the trial site.

SET-UP

Exhibitors are allowed to set up beginning at 12:00 noon on Friday and at 6:30 am on Saturday and Sunday mornings. Set up times end when runs for the day are completed. **Mats are not allowed on the upper concourse crating area.**

TRIAL HOURS

The building will be open at 12:00 noon on Friday and at 6:30 am on Saturday and Sunday. Self-service check-in will begin at 12:00 pm on Friday and at 7:00 am on Saturday and Sunday. Judging will begin no earlier than 1:00 pm on Friday, and 8:00 am on Saturday and Sunday. Exact running order will be determined after entries close and will be provided in the Judging Program.

WALK-THRUS & WARM-UPS

Handlers are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. Each walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class/jump height.

RING DIMENSIONS & SURFACE

The rings are 90 x 100 (approximately 9,000 square feet). The surface is packed dirt, and the trial site is an indoor, air-conditioned arena. This set of trials may use electronic timers.

REFUND POLICY

- Entry fees will be refunded if an entry is pulled before the closing date and time.
- No refunds will be made for any entry pulled after the closing date.
- The club will provide full refunds less \$5 per run for bitches in season. Veterinary verification in writing must be submitted to the Trial Secretary no later than 30 minutes before the start of the trials. Refunds will be mailed after the trial.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by veterinarian or judge, barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee, is ineligible to compete due to being entered incorrectly or if a trial cannot open or be completed.
- Entry fees will not be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

AWARDS

Ribbons/Rosettes: Rosettes will be awarded to the 1st through 4th place dogs in each Standard and JWW class in each jump height. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to dogs receiving a qualifying score. Dogs must qualify to receive a placement ribbon. New Title rosettes will be available for new titles earned at this trial. MACH and PAX Rosettes, along with a MACH/PAX pole will be available for dogs earning those titles at this trial. First Place finishers in each class receive a toy valued at less than \$5. Awards will not be mailed.

MOVE UPS

Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that the request is received in writing by the Trial Secretary, no later than 6 pm on the Monday preceding the event. (See the move-up deadline date on the cover of this premium). Day-to-day move ups are allowed provided the Trial Secretary is notified at the show site, in writing within 30 minutes of the last dog completing the course. Forms will be available at the show site. Once a trial has closed its entries, a dog cannot be moved from Novice A to Novice B.

ENTRY CONFIRMATIONS & JUDGING PROGRAMS

An email confirmation will be sent at the time of processing if a legible, valid email address is provided on the entry form. Additional confirmations will be emailed to acknowledge move-ups and corrections/changes. A final confirmation and the judging program will be emailed after the trial closes. If you cannot receive a Microsoft Word text file, or if you do not check your email, do not include your email address. Printed confirmations and Judging Programs are mailed to exhibitors without email addresses after the trial closes. **OWNERS/HANDLERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR REVIEWING ALL INFORMATION IN THE CONFIRMATION LETTER EACH TIME IT IS SENT AND CONTACTING THE TRIAL SECRETARY IMMEDIATELY IN WRITING (EMAIL) IF A CORRECTION/CHANGE NEEDS TO BE MADE. CORRECT AKC REGISTRATION # OR PAL #, ILP #, OR AKC CANINE PARTNERS LISTING # IS CRUCIAL.**

NOTE: If you have a spam filter in place on your email account, please add the trial secretary's email address to your accepted address list. If you are not receiving emails from the trial secretary, it is your responsibility to notify the trial secretary to reach a resolution.

Any exhibitor who does not receive a preliminary confirmation within 10 days of mailing a paper entry should contact the Trial Secretary to confirm receipt of paper entry.

Any exhibitor who does not receive the Judging Program within five (5) days prior to the trial, should contact the Trial Secretary. Always bring a paper copy of your confirmation letter to the trial. Corrections to the confirmation letter that are not brought to the trial secretary's attention at the time of receipt will render the database as the final authority for the day's information.

ARMBAND REQUIREMENT

All competitors **MUST** wear armbands while running. Competitors will not be admitted to the rings without their armbands visible.

ELIGIBILITY

This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are registerable breeds that have obtained an AKC ILP or PAL number. Mixed breed dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partners are also eligible to participate provided their listing number has been recorded on the entry form. Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations, it includes both sexes.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes.

CLASSES & TITLES OFFERED

Classes offered at this trial are listed on the front of this premium. Please see the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for current class descriptions. Dogs must be entered only in Regular Classes or Preferred Classes with no cross-over between classes allowed at the same set of trials.

DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL SITE

From Interstate 30 east or west, exit on From Interstate 30 just west of downtown Fort Worth, take the UNIVERSITY DR NORTH ramp around and turn left (North) on University Drive. Go .6 miles (6/10 of a mile) to the light at Harley Drive. Turn left onto Harley Drive. The building ahead is Watt Arena. Maps to the trial site and a map of the Will Rogers Memorial Complex will be sent with the judging program.

HEIGHT DIVISIONS

Owners, exhibitors, and/or handlers are responsible for entering their dogs in the proper height division. Exhibitors may choose to enter their dogs in a higher height division than required by AKC, but not in a height division lower than the AKC mandated height. NOTICE TO NOVICE EXHIBITORS

You must change your entry from Novice A to Novice B once your dog earns its first title in any class. Note that this is **NOT** considered a move-up, but rather an entry change.

However you may make this change **ONLY** if trial entries have not closed. If trial entries have closed, you will remain in the class you originally entered. Remember - once a trial has closed, you cannot change your Novice entry. Even if you elect to submit a move-up to Open for the class in which you received your first Novice title, you will remain in Novice A in the remaining class(es) *if* entries have closed.

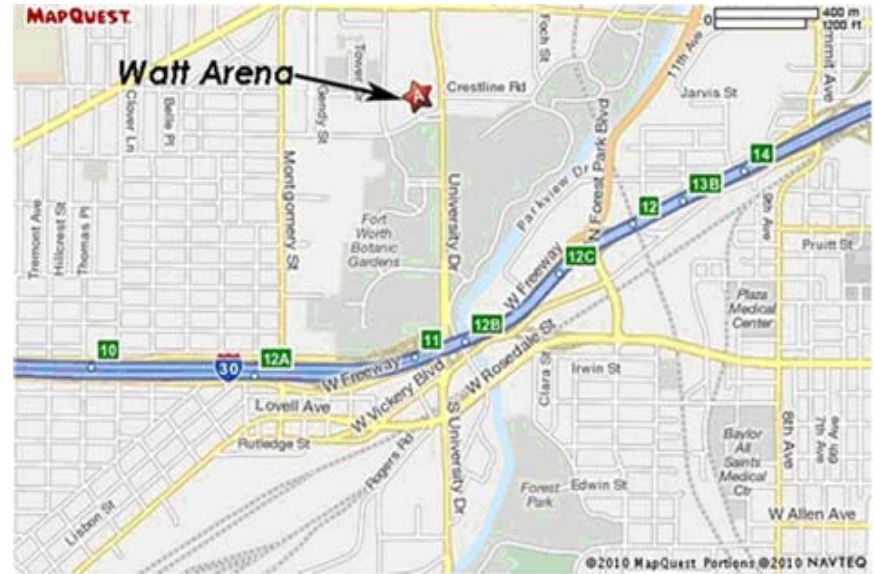
