Time 2 Beat is a new agility class recommended by the 2009 AKC Agility Advisory Committee. This event is being offered as a special attraction demonstration. Time 2 Beat is a "hybrid" class built primarily from obstacles from Jumpers With Weaves, with the option of having one to two contacts included on the course. This class is unique, as each dog has the chance to set the "Time to Beat" for each jump height division. All levels (Excellent, Open, and Novice run the same course.)

ENTRY FEES

DAILY entry fees are \$22 for the 1st entry of a dog (includes AKC \$3 recording fee), and \$12 for additional entries of the same dog (includes additional AKC \$3 event service fee).

ENTRY INFORMATION

YOU CAN NOW ENTER THE TRIAL VIA AKC'S ONLINE ENTRY SERVICE

Go to the AKC Agility Online Entry Services home page at www.akc.org/AgilityEntry and follow the instructions there to use your 'My AKC' account to enter this event online. . (Please note that AKC charges a small processing fee for online entries.) During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online or paper will be as follows: 25% online entries (165 runs) and 75% paper entries (495 runs). If either form of entry (paper or online) has not filled at the end of the 48 hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either one accordingly.

Hand deliveries will not be accepted during the first 24 hours after the trial's opening.*

- Limit: 10 entries per envelope. One entry = one dog. Envelopes containing more than 10 entries will be returned.
- Paper entries received within 24 hours of the opening date & time must: 1) include postage or be metered; 2) be delivered by a multi-state or multi-national postal or carrier service, including but not limited to USPS, FedEx, UPS & DHL. If above conditions are not met, the entries are not valid and must be returned to sender. **You must waive signature requirements when using services that utilize signature verifications.**
- Owners are responsible for ensuring that entry forms are completed IN FULL. Entries submitted without ALL information will be returned as invalid.
- All entries must be submitted on official AKC agility entry forms (7/09), one dog per entry form. Photocopies of entry form will be accepted only if legible and official AKC size.
- Entries will not be accepted without signature, fees and reverse side of entry form with agreement signed, nor will credit cards or faxed entries be accepted with paper entries.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry; no refund for duplicate entries. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$25 service charge for returned checks.

NEW SIMPLIFIED JUMP HEIGHT CARD PROCESS

NEW ENTRY FORM: The new entry form has a section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or if your dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the *Dogs To Be Measured List*. **It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.**

All agility dogs are required to have an Official Jump Height Card/Valid yellow form and exhibitors must be able to present it at any time during the trial **upon request**. All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. However, if a **Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO)** or an **Agility Field Rep** is present; **ALL** dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form **must** be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. **If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.**

NEW – WAIT LIST - REFUND POLICY

DOTC is offering a Wait List to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing date/time. A maximum of twenty-five (25) entries will be placed on the club's wait list. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to the trial closing date as listed on the front of this Premium. Any entries withdrawn that are received by 6:00 pm the Monday prior to the first day of the trial will be replaced by a wait listed entry if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by 6:00 pm the Monday prior to the first day of the trial will receive a full refund.

EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

- Choke collars, pinch collars, prong collars, electric and dummy electric collars are prohibited on trial grounds.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.
- Running order will be determined by computer-generated random draw. Handlers with multiple dogs in one class will have those dogs separated as much as possible.
- All dogs present *must* be on leash or confined in crates when not being judged or at the warm up jump.
- Puppies under six months of age are NOT allowed in the trial site.
- Free parking is available for exhibitors. Park at your own risk.
- Exhibitors may wear shirts or insignia of their training group.
- The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all the obstacles safely.
- The Club and the Trial Secretary have no obligation or responsibility to provide a public address system or stewards to call or locate dogs that are not present at the ring when required. Exhibitors are responsible for being at the gate when it is their turn to run.
- The Club and the Trial Facility assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers or to any of their dogs or property and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.
- Exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. No refund of entry fees will be made.
- Dogs may not be left overnight at the trial site.

SET-UP

Exhibitors are allowed to set up beginning at 7:00 am on Saturday morning.

TRIAL HOURS

The trial grounds will be open at 7:00 am. Self-service check-in will begin at 7 am, and judging will begin no earlier than 8 a.m. Exact running order will be determined after entries close and will be provided in the Judging Program.

WALK-THRU'S & WARM-UPS

Handlers are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. Each walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class/jump height.

RING DIMENSIONS & SURFACE

The rings are approximately: Standard-90' X 100'; JWW- 90' X 90'. The trial will be held indoors on packed dirt in a non-climate-controlled (neither air-conditioned nor heated) arena. This set of trials uses electronic timers.

REFUND POLICY

- Entry fees will be refunded if an entry is pulled before the closing date and time.
- No refunds will be made for any entry pulled after the closing date.
- The club will provide full refunds less \$5 per class entered for bitches in season. Veterinary verification in writing must be submitted to the Trial Secretary no later than 30 minutes before the start of the trials. Refunds will be mailed after the trial.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by veterinarian or judge, barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee, is ineligible to compete due to being entered incorrectly or if a trial cannot open or be completed.
- Entry fees will not be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

AWARDS

Ribbons/Rosettes: Rosettes will be awarded to the 1st through 4th place dog in each class in each jump height. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. Dogs must qualify to receive placement ribbons. A plush dog toy valued at \$3 to \$5 will be awarded for 1st place in each jump height. [These awards do not apply to the Time 2 Beat Demo.]

MOVE UPS

Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that the request is received in writing by the Trial Secretary, no later than 6 pm on the Monday preceding the event. (See the move-up deadline date on the cover of this premium). Day-to-day move ups are allowed provided the Trial Secretary is notified at the show site, in writing within 30 minutes of the last dog completing the course. Forms will be available at the show site. Once a trial has closed its entries, a dog cannot be moved from Novice A to Novice B.

No form is necessary, but please include the following information:

- The class and jump height to which you would like your dog moved

Your request must be received by the deadline noted on the cover of this Premium.

ENTRY CONFIRMATIONS & JUDGING PROGRAMS

An email confirmation will be sent at the time of processing if a legible, valid email address is provided on the entry form. Additional confirmations will be emailed to acknowledge move-ups and corrections/changes (prior to closing). A final confirmation and the judging program will be emailed after the trial closes. If you cannot receive a Microsoft Word text file, or if you do not check your email, do NOT include your email address. Printed confirmations and Judging Programs are mailed to exhibitors without email addresses after the trial closes. **OWNERS/HANDLERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR REVIEWING ALL INFORMATION IN THE CONFIRMATION LETTER EACH TIME IT IS SENT AND CONTACTING THE TRIAL SECRETARY IMMEDIATELY IN WRITING (EMAIL) IF A CORRECTION/CHANGE NEEDS TO BE MADE. CORRECT AKC REGISTRATION # OR ILP # IS CRUCIAL.**

NOTE: If you have a spam filter in place on your email account, please add the trial secretary's email address to your accepted address list. If you are not receiving emails from the trial secretary, it is your responsibility to notify the trial secretary to reach a resolution.

Any exhibitor who does not receive the Judging Program within five (5) days prior to the trial, should contact the Trial Secretary. Always bring a paper copy of your confirmation letter to the trial. Corrections to the confirmation letter that are not brought to the trial secretary's attention at the time of receipt will render the database as the final authority for the day's information.

ELIGIBILITY

This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are registerable breeds that have obtained an AKC ILP or PAL number. Mixed breed dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partners are also eligible to participate provided their listing number has been recorded on the entry form. Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations, it includes both sexes. Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes.

CLASSES & TITLES OFFERED

Classes offered at this trial are listed on the front of this premium. Please see the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for current class descriptions. Dogs must be entered only in Regular Classes or Preferred Classes with no cross-over between classes allowed at the same set of trials.

DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL SITE

The town of McKinney is about 33 miles north of downtown Dallas on U.S. 75/North Central Expressway. From the north or south: On U.S. 75, take the U.S. 380 exit and go west about 2.5 miles to FM1461. Turn right (north) on FM1461 and travel approximately 2.9 miles to County Road 166. Turn right (north) on County Road 166 and go .8 (8/10) miles to the site which is on the left. The county has posted directional signs to the Event Center.

All competitors **MUST** wear armbands while running. Competitors will not be admitted to the rings without their armbands visible.

Hookups are not available. \$15/night – Call **972-548-4792** to let them know you're coming. The main gate will not be locked at night. **Pay Myers Park personnel at the show site. The trial committee cannot accept payment.**

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs immediately on hotel/motel and show grounds. Motels/hotels require that dogs be crated when unattended; no bathing or grooming of dogs in guest rooms. Exhibitors/handlers are responsible for any damages to motels/hotels or the event site and may result in disciplinary action by the Trial Committee. Entries may be refused in the future for previous misuse of the motel facilities. This is an AKC-supported measure.

NOTE: Please inform management of your dogs when you book reservations and when you register. Motel dog regulations and fees may change without notice. The club cannot be responsible for any changes. Some new motels are being built in the area, so check with your favorite hotels/motels for updated listings.

HEIGHT DIVISIONS

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division. Exhibitors may choose to enter their dogs in a higher height division than required by AKC, but not in a height division lower than the AKC mandated height. Dogs in the Preferred Classes **MUST** jump their preferred class jump height. They may not enter in a higher jump class.

NOTICE TO NOVICE EXHIBITORS

You must change your entry from Novice A to Novice B once your dog earns its first title in any class. Note that this is **NOT** considered a move-up but rather an entry change.

However you may make this change **ONLY** if trial entries have not closed. If trial entries have closed, you will remain in the class you originally entered. Remember - once a trial has closed, you cannot change your Novice entry. Even if you elect to submit a move-up to Open for the class in which you received your first Novice title, you will remain in Novice A in the remaining class(es) *if* entries have closed.

PER THE CITY OF MCKINNEY, DOGS ARE NOT ALLOWED BY THE GAZEBO OR IN THE LAKE AREA TO THE NORTH OF THE TRIAL BUILDING. EXHIBITORS AND DOGS ARE RESTRICTED TO THE SHOW BARN, PARKING LOT AND ADJACENT GRASSY AREAS.
