MOVE UPS:

Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that the request is made to the Trial Secretary in writing not later than 6:00 PM of Monday, March 1, 2010. Dogs qualifying for a title on March 5 or 6 may be moved up to a higher class for the following day provided the request is made to the Trial Secretary in writing at the trial site until 30 minutes after the end of judging that day. **If an email address is provided, email notification of your move-up will be sent prior to closing as move-ups are processed. If you do not receive an email confirmation of your move-up, please verify receipt of your move-up with the trial secretary.**

PRIZES AND AWARDS:

Classes will have rosettes awarded for 1st through 4th place in each jump height. Dogs must qualify to receive placement rosettes. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving qualifying scores. MACH rosettes will be awarded to those completing a MACH title. New title ribbons will be awarded to those completing all other types of agility titles. Dog toys or bowls valued between \$1.00 to \$2.50 will be awarded to 1st place in each jump height. A dog toy will be awarded to any dog that has two qualifying runs in one day regardless of level.

SCHEDULE:

Registration on Friday begins at 1:00 PM with judging at 2:00 PM. Saturday's registration begins at 7:00 am with judging at 8:00 a.m. Sunday's registration for those not entered on Saturday begins at 7:15 am and judging begins at 8:00 am. Agility competitors may access the site at 1:30 PM on Friday & 7:00 AM on Saturday & Sunday.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club, or are of a registerable breed that have obtained an AKC ILP/PAL number. Exception: bitches in season, aggressive dogs or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect its physical or mental performance. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

OBSTACLES & EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

- Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials.
- All exhibitors and/or handlers are responsible for entering their dogs in the proper height classification. In the Regular classes dogs may run in a higher height division, but not a lower height division than their measured height division. In the Preferred Class dogs MUST jump their measured height division.
- **PUPPIES UNDER THE AGE OF SIX MONTHS ARE STRICTLY PROHIBITED FROM ENTRY ONTO THE SHOW SITE.**
- Entries for a maximum of 10 dogs are allowed in each envelope submitted to the Trial Secretary.
- On-line entries will not be accepted for this trial.
- Paper entries received within 24 hours of the opening date & time must include: postage or be metered; be delivered by a multi-state or multi-national postal or carrier service (**NO** hand deliveries are permitted within the first 24 hours the trial is open)
- If an email address is provided, email notification of your entry status will be sent prior to closing as entries are processed.
- **If an email address is provided, email notification of your move-up will be sent prior to closing as move-ups are processed. If you do not receive an email confirmation of your move-up, please verify receipt of your move-up with the trial secretary**
- If an email address is provided, confirmations & judging schedules will be sent via email after closing. Confirmations & judging schedules will only be mailed to those who did not provide an email address or the email address is not valid.
- Running orders will be available online for printing after midnight the first day of the trial at www.agilitypremium.com. Running orders will be posted at the trial but individual running orders will not be available.
- Entry Agreement must be attached to entry form for the entry to be valid. Entries received without the entry agreement are not valid & will be returned.
- If a Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO) or an AKC representative is in attendance at the trial, all dogs must be measured who do not have a valid height card including dogs who are over 22" at the withers

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

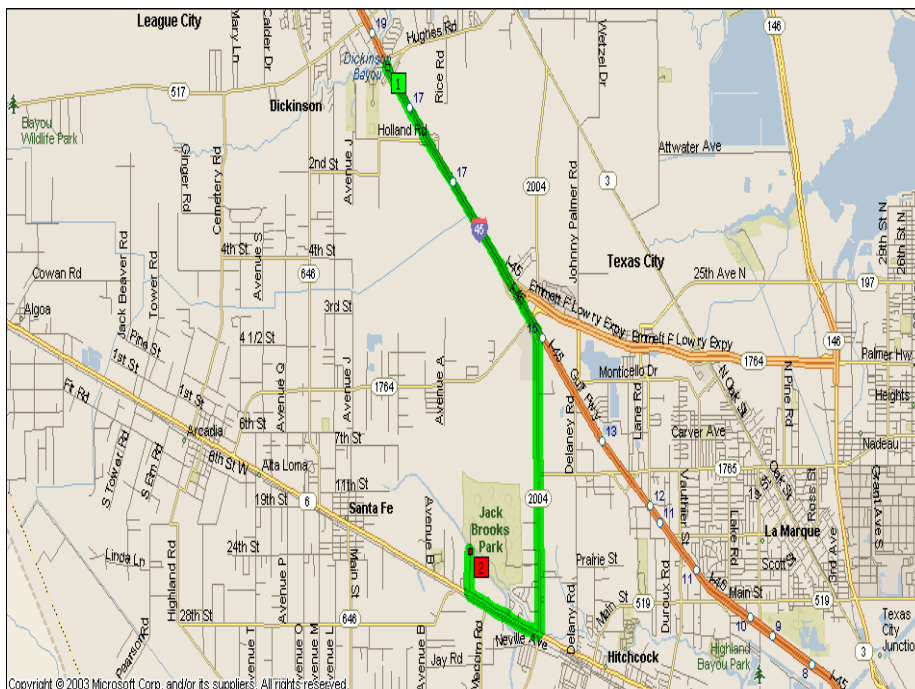
- **Entries not on Official AKC entry Forms or Entry Forms without Agreement and Rules attached are NOT ACCEPTABLE.**
- Unsigned Entry Forms cannot be accepted or entries which specify any conditions as to its acceptance. Telegraph, Telephone and Fax Entries cannot be accepted.
- The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this Trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- NASA Area Dog Fanciers Association and its agents, etc. assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.
- Entry fee will not be refunded in the event that the dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. No entry fee will be returned if the Trial cannot open or be completed by reason of civil disturbance, fire, and act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. A \$20.00 service fee will be added for all returned checks.
- No refund for duplicate entries. Care will be taken to find duplicates; however, if an entry has been processed no refund will be made.
- Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after published closing date. PLEASE PRINT OR TYPE CLEARLY.
- All dogs present must be on leash or confined to crates or ex-pens when not being judged except when in the designated warm-up area.
- It is expressly understood that the exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the Trial site. In such a case, no refund of any entry fees will be made.
- Bitches in season are not permitted in the Trial. Host club will refund all but \$20 per day of entry fee for bitches unable to compete for that reason. The Trial Secretary must receive written certification from a veterinarian no later than 30 minutes prior to the start of the first class of the day. Such refunds will be sent by mail within ten working days following the last day of the event.
- Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. Judge need not wait for any dog holding up a class. NASA Area Dog Fanciers Association and the Trial Secretary have no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards for the purposes of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.
- Crates and ex-pens may be left in the area designated for crating for the duration of the Trial, but exhibitors do so at their own risk. Security will **NOT** be provided during Trial hours. NASA Area Dog Fanciers Association assumes no responsibility for any thing lost or stolen. No dogs may be left at the Trial site overnight.
- Exhibitors are responsible for picking up after their own dogs. Failure to do so could result in being excused from the Trial.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
- Checks may be deposited prior to closing. Refunds for dogs pulled prior to closing will be mailed up to 10 business days after the trial.

From north: South on I-45 (Gulf Freeway) Take Exit 15 (FM 2004) Turn right on FM 2004. Stay on FM 2004. At Hwy. 6 turn right. Park entrance is on your right.

From West: Take Highway 6 from Alvin. Park is on the left.



HELP WANTED

Looking for a way to reduce the cost of future entry fees?

- Trial workers will be given a voucher to use towards the next NADFA trial entry for each class/jump height that they work
- Trial workers may sign up prior to the trial via the volunteer form located below or at the show site with the volunteer coordinator
- Worker vouchers will be \$6 per class/jump height worked when the class or jump height is less than 50 dogs. When the class/jump height is 50 dogs or more, then the worker voucher will be \$8 for the class/jump height worked. Chute fluffers will earn \$10 per class/jump height.
- Course Builders will earn \$8 for full builds and a Food voucher for tweaks between levels.
- Worker vouchers must be sent in with the entries for future agility trials offered by NADFA club. The total amount of vouchers submitted for any single entry can not exceed the entry fees itself minus \$20 per day per dog.
- To earn a voucher for a class/jump height, you must work the entire class/jump height assigned or volunteered for.
- Water, soda and snacks for trial workers will be provided by PAWSitive Impact Agility for this trial.
- Lunch will be provided through vouchers to the food vendor \$3 per class worked.
- Workers Raffle will be held each day for a one day one dog entry for the next NADFA Agility Trial tickets for the raffle will be distributed with the worker vouchers.

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend, and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division. All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Mixed breed classes may only be offered at standalone all-breed AKC agility trials. A standalone agility event is defined as an agility trial that is not held on the same date and show site as an AKC All-Breed Dog Show or Independent Specialty for conformation. Dogs entered in the mixed breed classes must list the breed name as "mixed breed" and not as a breed hybrid.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 816-3776. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?

If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Mixed breed classes may only be offered at standalone all-breed AKC agility trials. A standalone agility event is defined as an agility trial that is not held on the same date and show site as an AKC All-Breed Dog Show or Independent Specialty for conformation. Dogs entered in the mixed breed classes must list the breed name as "mixed breed" and not as a breed hybrid.
